

feld to find your resource. USF has over 11,000 resources available across all campuses uploaded by various departments and your colleagues. To find USF approved




Resources can be a variety of types. Resources can be a complete course, a module, a page, a quiz, etc. They will be ident fed as such with a labeled icon.
