The University of South Florida System comprises three member institutions, each with separate classifications assigned by the Carnegie Classification of Institutions of Higher Education:

- USF Tampa is classified as Doctoral Universities: Highest Research Activity.
- USF St. Petersburg is classified as Master's Colleges & Universities: Medium Programs.
- USF Sarasota-Manatee is classified as Master's Colleges & Universities: Small Programs.

   In 2018, the Florida Board of Governors designated USF Tampa as a Preeminent State Research University, placing USF in the most elite category among the state's 12 public universities.

- USF's fall 2018 Freshman academic profile posts an average SAT score of 1283 and a high school GPA of 4.09.
- The Morsani College of Medicine brought in its most selective incoming medical student cohort to date, with an average MCAT score of 515, placing it among the top of all medical schools in the country.
- The University of South Florida System is home to a student body of 50,755 students representing over 145 different countries.

- USF ranks #14 in student success among 1,100 public research and doctoral universities according to the 2017 Eduventures Student Success Ratings.
- USF Tampa is recognized by The Education Trust as being #6 in the nation for eliminating the completion gap between black and white students, #4 in the nation for Latino student success, and #1 in the state of Florida for both (2017).
- USF Tampa is recognized as #1 by *The Chronicle of Higher Education* (2017) for greatest improvement in 6-year graduation rates among 4-year public colleges and universities.

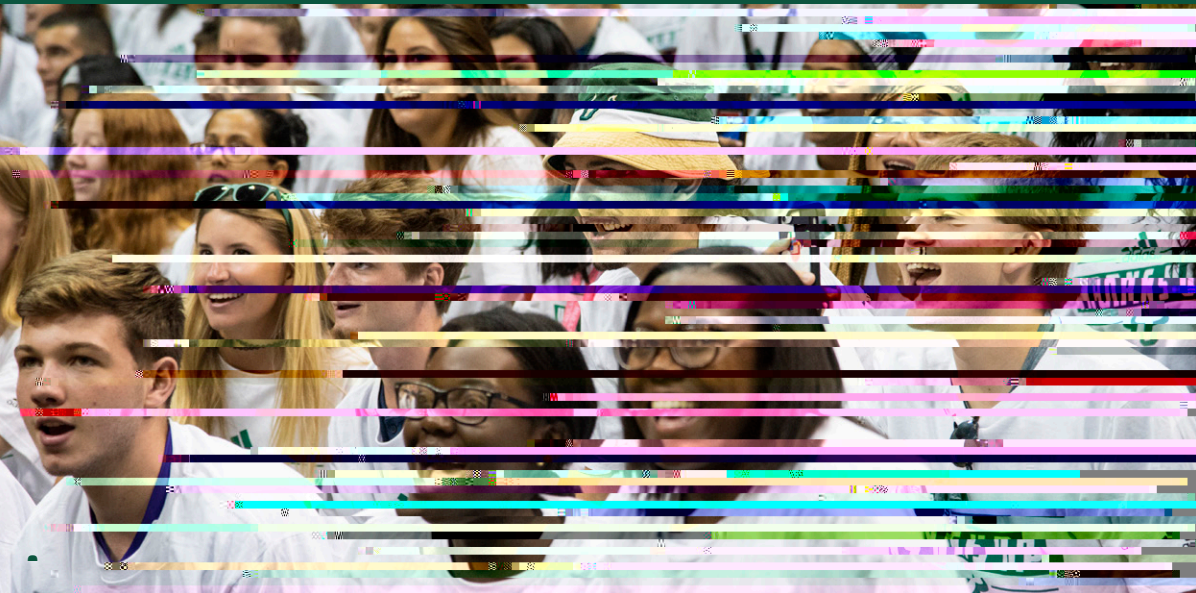
- USF Tampa is a recognized "Top Producer" of Peace Corps Volunteers, ranking 3rd in the Nation (among Graduate Schools) for Peace Corps Volunteers in 2018.

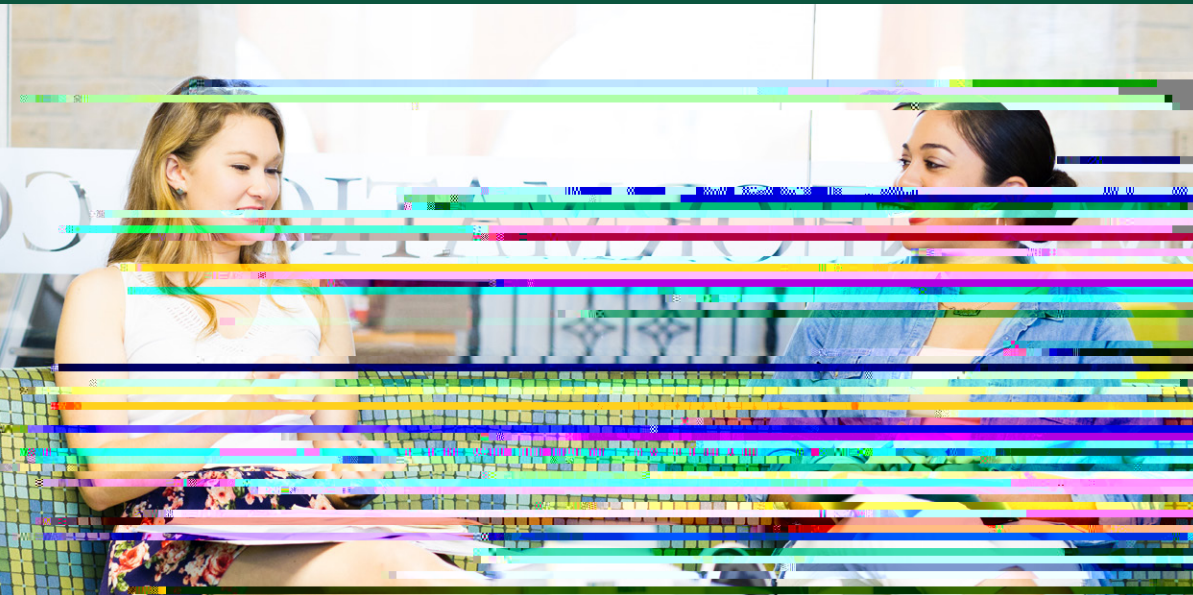

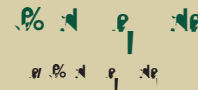
Number of new transfer students*

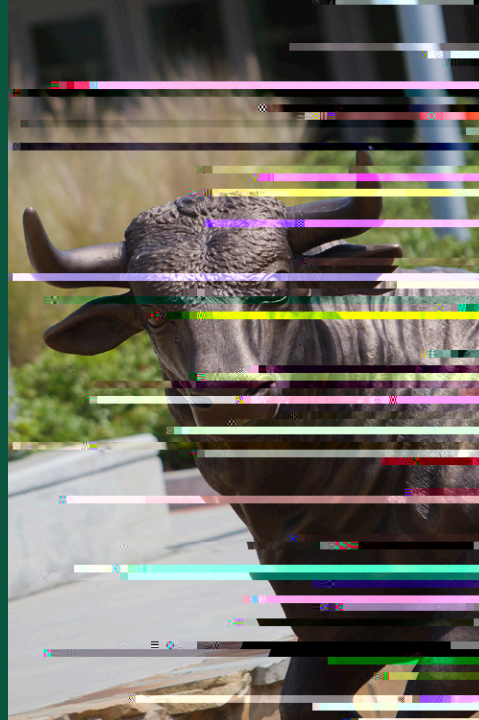

A designated “Preeminent State Research University,” the University of South Florida is one of the nation’s top public research universities and one of 49 public research universities nationwide classified as both a Doctoral University with “Highest Research Activity” and as a “Community Engaged” institution by the Carnegie Classification of Institutions of Higher Education.

The University of South Florida is classified by the Carnegie Foundation for the Advancement of Teaching in the Doctoral Universities: Highest Research Activity category, a distinction attained by only 2.5 percent of all universities. USF comprises the main campus in Tampa, USF Health, and the College of Marine Science and is the doctoral granting, research-intensive member of the USF System.

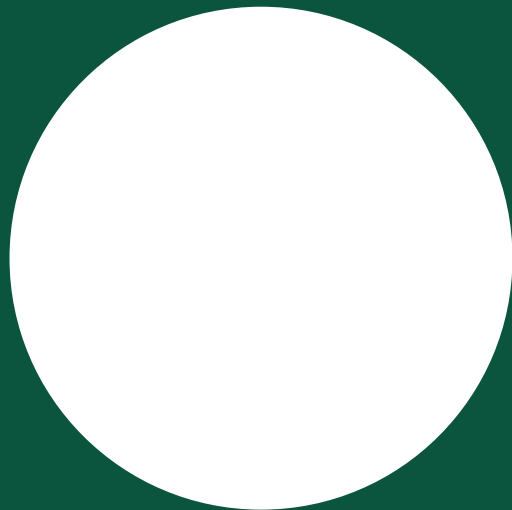

Offering more than 40 graduate and undergraduate programs in the arts and sciences, business and education, USF St. Petersburg (USFSP) is Pinellas County's only residential public research university. USFSP features small classes taught by faculty who challenge their students to excel through innovative approaches to learning and collaborative research opportunities. Located in downtown St. Petersburg, USFSP offers distinct opportunities for all students to engage with the community through internships and field-based experiences. USF St. Petersburg is part of a select group of Master's Medium institutions that earned the highly prestigious Carnegie Classification for Community Engagement.

USFSP's core values include student-centered success, research and innovation, inclusion of differences, commitment to community and care for the natural environment. Student success tops the list, with a focus on building a distinctive community of learning with a strong sense of place. This is followed by a desire to achieve in new areas of research and innovation. In 2016-17, USFSP was awarded \$5.5 million in research funds, an all-time high.



As a regional institution of the University of South Florida, USF Sarasota-Manatee is a student-centered, community-engaged, forward-thinking institution that empowers students to lead lives of impact. Located in the heart of Sarasota and Manatee counties, USF Sarasota-Manatee provides high quality bachelor's and master's degrees and certificates in a personalized learning community that prepares students to think critically and creatively to meet the business and workforce needs of a growing community.

USF Sarasota-Manatee has an enrollment of over 2,000 students who take day and evening classes on campus and online. USF Sarasota-Manatee serves a variety of student populations, including recent high school graduates, transfer and graduate students, veterans, first-generation college students, and working professionals seeking new opportunities or executive education to advance their careers. With a student-to-faculty ratio of 13:1, many classes have fewer than 20 students, and professors know their students by name. USF Sarasota-Manatee places an emphasis on helping students engage in hands-on experiential learning opportunities, including internships, research with expert faculty, and service-learning.
