Each team shall designate a captain. The captain will act as the spokesperson for the team and

- o The umpire must determine if the interference occurred before or after the runner who interfered was put out and then apply the proper rule.
- o It is also considered interference, if, in the judgment of the umpire, there is an obvious attempt

Section 4: Pitching Windup

o The pitcher may use any windup desired, provided:

They do not make any motion to pitch without immediately delivering the ball to the batter.

Their windup is continuous motion.

They do

o The batting order must alternate genders. If a team is short either a male or female the following rules apply:

If two (2) people of the same gender hit in a row, the team must take an automatic out between them. If two people of the same gender are batting in a row, and the first person is the last out of an inning, the team will start with an automatic out the next inning before the next batter of the same gender

More than one fielder attempts to field a batted ball and the base runner comes in contact with the one who, in the umpire's judgment, was not entitled to field the ball.

When a base runner is hit with a fair-batted ball that has hit a fielder first, before striking the runner.

PITCHING

Each team will pitch to the opposing team.

Each batter will start with a 1-1 count, which means 1 ball and 1 strike.

Players will not be walked if hit by a pitch, this will be considered a ball.

PLAYOFFS
