USCIS Premium Processing Fee Hike in Effect February 26, 2024

Premium processing is an optional service offered by USCIS to expedite the processing time of certain petitions. The premium processing fee for OPT and STEM petitions increased from \$1500 to \$1685 and the premium processing fee for change of status in the US to F-2, J-1, or J-2 increased from \$1750 to \$1965.

USCIS Petition Filing Fee Change. Despite the advantage of the current filing fees, for students changing their status, the fee will increase by \$5 from \$370 to \$420. The paper filing fee
